Bisque Firings: \$14 per shelf Glaze Firings: \$18 per shelf

Shelf size: Half Round 26" (L) \times 13" (W) \times 6"

Details:

- Price is per shelf, not per piece, so minimum price is \$14.
- If your piece is taller than 6" you will be charged for another shelf.
- If your piece(s) don't entirely fit on the shelf, you will be charged for another shelf.
- MUST use glaze and clay rated to cone ^6. We bisque fire to cone 04 and glaze fire to cone 6.
- If you use Mayco Stroke and Coat (and other similar types of glazes) on greenware, you must disclose this. You can still use it, but you will be charge for a glaze firing.
- The bottom 1/8th of your piece must be glaze free (preferably with a waxed bottom). Place your glazes pieces on cookies (customer provided), if glaze drips damage the shelves you will be charged for any damages.
- To ensure your greenware arrives safely, best practices are to bring it will it's still mostly leather hard. We can keep it covered and allow it to finish drying here.
- MUST have your pieces clearly marked with your name.

Disclaimers:

- Kilns are firing between 1945 degrees and 2232 degrees. A lot can happen. Portland Clay House is not responsible for damaged pieces or undesirable glaze results. We will do our best to ensure your pottery is well cared for.
- We will do our best to have your pieces fired within 7-10 days, but do not make any guarantees. Turn around times will vary depending on studio workload.
- We will email you when your piece is ready. You must pick up your pieces within 30 days or we will dispose of it.
